## Spears® Marine Bonder Qualification Procedure (ASME B31.3)

The program consists of the following:

- Threading and Flanging Process
- Question & Answer Segment
- Hands-on Demonstration and Participation by Every Class Member
- Short Test

Training cards are issued to bonders once the cemented joints pass a required hydrostatic leak test conducted to ASME requirements by Spears<sup>®</sup> Manufacturing Company.
